

## CRAVEN ARMS COVID-19 STATEMENT

While we are excited about reopening, your safety and that of our staff is our greatest priority. We have made changes to the way we will operate and we have taken steps to put restrictions in place. With your support and understanding we aim to move forward very slowly and will only be operating at 40% capacity.

We are lucky to have lots of different room spaces and a large beer garden and have planned on how best to utilise the space with your safety in mind.

A new risk-based approach to cleaning has been implemented and all staff will be trained accordingly. Hand sanitisers are available and visible at several points and on all dining tables.

We will adhere to restrictions relating to dining capacity while social distancing is required. We will take all necessary measures to deliver minimum contact, ensuring hygiene standards and social distancing. These measures include single use menus and wipeable wine lists.

Children must remain seated for now and supervised by parents at all times while on the premises with regard to safety and social distancing.

All staff will have undergone Covid-19 and service procedure training and we have undergone a Company Risk Assessment. All staff will have their temperature taken on arrival to work and we would ask members of the public, if they are feeling unwell or have any symptoms to not visit.

We have been asked by the Government to collect data which will require your name and contact details. These will be held for three weeks and then destroyed, unless agreed otherwise.
